We have received the following question (which you will be able to find in our FAQ (frequently asked questions) and answer section. We are adding this new question here in case you find you can't maneuver on the web-page. Generally, there are many browsers and as they age and new software becomes available, it can get glitchy to expect all of the browsers to work alike. There are three versions of Internet Explorer in use now and they do not translate the page in the same way. Most people have IE 7, which is not compatible with IE 8, and to use IE 9, you must also be using Windows 7. Confused? Read below for the question and answer:

Q.: Using Internet Explorer, I cannot see or access the links bar that is supposed to be on the left hand side of the church home page.

A.: Until we have a resolution for Internet Explorer, try one of the other popular browsers. Current versions (as of 6/18/2011) all work with our website.
