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### **3. THIS SUNDAY – “A RESPONSE TO RELIGIOUS HATRED” – THE REV. BARBARA GADON**

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**June 28:** Rev. Barbara Gadon — “A Response to Religious Hatred” Given the recent murder in the Holocaust Museum, of Dr. George Tiller and others, we feel great sorrow, bewilderment and anger toward people who have felt compelled by their religion to acts of violence. Can we make sense of

this? How do we respond?

The music this week consists of Spirituals arranged by Harry T. Burleigh, a classically trained composer and singer. He took on the project of making Spirituals available to classical musicians. Before his project, Spirituals were taught by rote and handed down through the generations. Burleigh was born in 1866 and died in 1949. His mother was a daughter of a slave.

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#### **4. SOCIAL JUSTICE OFFERING TO GO TO LIMEN HOUSE**

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The recipient organization for our Social Justice Offering this month is Limen House. Located in Wilmington, it is a half-way house for people recovering from alcohol and drug abuse. It offers a residential, therapeutic treatment program; with the capacity to treat 25 clients. Limen House exists to break the cycle of addiction. It offers hope to those who had none, spiritual growth where there had been spiritual emptiness. Limen House has been in operation since 1969, making it one of the oldest and most successful half-way houses in the United States. It has been recognized by the State of Delaware for its excellence, and United Way of Delaware has given it its highest rating. Past members of its Board have included Phyllis Wynn, Parry Norling and Florence Rice.

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#### **5. MEMBERSHIP IS LOOKING FOR A FEW GOOD CHURCH MENTORS!**

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Church Mentorship is an exciting new program in our congregation and is open to all. A Church Mentor is anyone who assists new members as they become acclimated to the church: finding their way around, meeting other members, learning about programs and activities. It may be sitting with a new member during the worship service; accompanying the new member to coffee hour and introducing them around; visiting the playground after church if the new members have children; inviting them to go with you as you participate in church activities; it may even be attending new member classes with them, just to keep them company.
